Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

To advance animal welfare by providing fundraising support for animal welfare organisations in and around the Souss-Massa area of Morocco that are properly registered with Moroccan charitable status.

To advance public health in Morocco by providing fundraising support for properly registered organisations in the Souss-Massa area of Morocco who are implementing vaccination campaigns to prevent the spread of rabies among the non-owned animal populations.

To support registered animal welfare organisations in the Souss-Massa area in their governance and management to operate properly and with accountability to their supporters.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

In the first few months a website was created, bank and PayPal accounts were set up and MAWSS registered with online donation and payment processing platforms (Donorbox and STRIPE). We are now registered with Microsoft and Google as an eligible non-profit organisation. We are also signed up to receive donations via Give as You Live, Amazon Smile and Easyfundraising.

An early decision was taken to start small. We are a small team therefore it was important that we did not overwhelm the trustees and set ourselves up for failure. We agreed a set of criteria to help us decide who MAWSS could help. The criteria are intended to ensure that we partner with organisations who are properly registered as non-profit organisations with the Moroccan authorities and who work in a responsible and accountable manner. The full criteria are available on request.

By the end of our first year of operation we had received applications from two organisations, however only one organisation met the for support criteria.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Donated facilities and services (if any)

The Trustees received and approved an application for support from Association le Coeur sur la Patte|Sunshine Animal Refuge Agadir (CSPA|SARA). CSPA|SARA was first established in 2013 to support animals on the street in Agadir. Since then, it has developed to become the first organisation to partner with the local government to introduce TNVR in the city of Agadir and has rescued over 2000 animals.

Without our involvement it questionable whether CSPA would have been able to continue operating in the same way. Their previous fundraising partner had given them notice that they were about to fold, this would have led to shortfall of donations and possibly the closure of CSPA with disastrous consequences for the animals in their care.

In the last 12 months they have provided care for over 1200 animals and have sterilised 530 cats and 198 dogs and facilitated the adoption of over 60 animals abroad.

We have collected a total of £100 767 donations for them of which £86 053 was transferred to their bank account in Morocco and £9 805 used to pay EU expenses. The balance will be transferred to them in the new financial year. We have also assisted them in formalising their robust financial procedures into a written document.

Other optional information

Moroccan Animal Welfare Support Souss SCIO (MAWSS) was set up in 2021 to help previously established animal refuges and welfare organisations to fund raise and establish themselves on a professional and responsive basis. There is a massive problem with stray and roaming dogs, cats and donkeys in Morocco and rabies is endemic; the problem of stray animals is a public health concern as well as an animal welfare issue.

While there are many individuals and groups trying to help improve conditions, they are not always operating on a formal basis.

Morocco is still a developing country with much of the population living at subsistence levels and the issues of animal welfare are not currently given a high priority. While this is changing, it means that organisations in Morocco depend on donations from the rest of the world to help their cause.

There are certain difficulties for Moroccan based organisations as many foreign institutions do not recognise their charitable status. The lack of understanding of what a registered organisation is in Morocco and a perception of uncontrolled activity creates an issue of trust. In addition, there are some barriers within the banking system which make it difficult and expensive to accept donations from abroad.

While globally there are many people aware of the issues in Morocco, the above makes it difficult for potential donors to contribute.

The founding trustees were aware of the issues as they were frequent visitors to the Souss-Massa area and were animal lovers. They also had some interaction with local charities and saw the problems at first hand.

We hope that we can return to the other organisation who applied to us and help them to transition to an organisation that will meet our criteria, however that has not been possible this year.

The Trustees believe that our first year has given us a stable foundation on which to build and continue to support animal welfare in the Souss-Massa area.

Our aims for next year include

- · Supporting more organisations
- Open another bank account to enable the collection of Gift Aid
